

System-wide Results Management

Work Package 21 | Lead: Secretary-General's Special Adviser on Reform

OBJECTIVE

To strengthen and harmonize how organizations in the UN system measure, manage and communicate their results.

HOW WE GET THERE

- **Action 93: Develop an action plan that will operationalize a system-wide Management for Results (M4R) mechanism** that strengthens coherence, transparency and collective accountability across the UN system.

PROGRESS TO DATE

A concept for a practical UN system-wide mechanism for Management for Results has been developed. A draft action plan has been outlined to improve how the link between mandates, resources and results can be articulated, focused on a select number of agreed system-wide results. Consultations with UN system entities and Member States are under way to test the concept, practical options and overall viability of the proposed mechanism.

NEXT STEPS AND DECISIONS

- **Action 93:** The action plan will be finalized for consideration by the Secretary-General by June, in implementation of resolution A/RES/80/251. A Secretary-General's information brief is planned for **July**.
- No decision of an intergovernmental organ is envisaged at this stage.
