Work Package 25 | Leads: Deputy Secretary-General, Executive Director (UNAIDS)

OBJECTIVE

To sustain the UN system's action to end AIDS, sunsetting UNAIDS and mainstreaming its capacity and expertise into relevant entities of the UN development system.

HOW WE GET THERE

- **Action 29: Develop and implement a transition plan** to sunset the Joint UN Programme on HIV/AIDS (UNAIDS) and integrate its capacity and expertise into relevant entities of the UN development system.

PROGRESS TO DATE

The first phase of transformation is under way. This has included UNAIDS Secretariat downsizing, consolidation of the UNAIDS Secretariat country footprint and identification of the 11 cosponsoring organizations as leads or affiliates. The Programme Coordinating Board (PCB) has constituted a working group that has begun its work and has consulted Member States, cosponsoring organizations and UNAIDS Secretariat.

NEXT STEPS AND DECISIONS

- **Action 29:** The PCB will hold formal multistakeholder consultations, bringing together Member States, civil society and implementing partners in May and September. An interim report of the PCB working group will be discussed by the PCB in **June**, with a view to preparing a final transformation plan for PCB consideration by **October**. The outcome would then be transmitted to **ECOSOC** for decision in **November**. Separately, specialized agencies that are UNAIDS cosponsoring organizations would be invited to take corresponding decisions regarding their participation.
